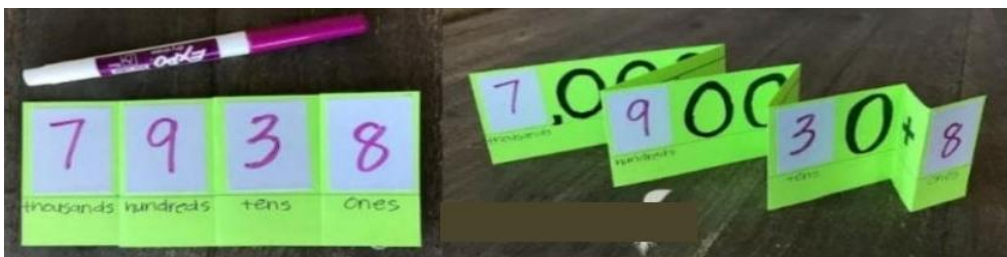

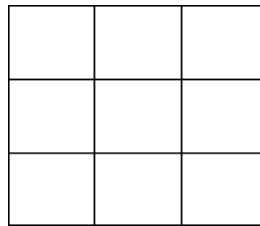
1. Place Value Foldable
